

Hypothecaria is the most common genus of  
lichens found on bark and wood in  
the woods of the Adirondack Park.  
Hypothecaria has a very simple  
body consisting of a thin  
layer of tissue on the bark of  
trees, overhanging and edging  
the foliage. It grows in  
extreme abundance in the  
old growth forest of the Adirondack  
Park, especially in the eastern  
part of the Park.
