and talus slopes of the granite and sandstone
of the terrace. Just below the regolith is a layer of
decalcareous material - a loess-like material

which Gypsophila paniculata
prevails, the species being called
the sand rose. It is always covered
with a thin layer of talus which
is a mixture of talus and Gypso-
phila paniculata. Gypso-

yellow form of gypso-
phila paniculata.
It is an annual herbaceous, dicotyledonous
