The Committee find, that the late Sir John
Lubbock, Bart., purchased the Museum of
Natural History, for the sum of £10,000,
from the Honorable Member for the County
of Middlesex, and that the purchase was
made in conformity with a resolution
passed by the House of Commons, on the
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
