

These are the words of our Lord Jesus Christ
 who was crucified for us, and who is now
 sitting at the right hand of the Father,
 and who will come again to judge the living
 and the dead. Amen.

The first part of the Mass is the Introit,
 which is a psalm or a verse from the Bible,
 and is usually followed by a short prayer.
 The second part is the Kyrie, which is a
 Greek word meaning 'Lord', and is usually
 followed by a short prayer.

The third part is the Gloria, which is a
 Latin word meaning 'Glory', and is usually
 followed by a short prayer.

The fourth part is the Credo, which is a
 Latin word meaning 'Belief', and is usually
 followed by a short prayer.

The fifth part is the Eucharist, which is
 the central part of the Mass, and is usually
 followed by a short prayer.

The sixth part is the Communion, which is
 the final part of the Mass, and is usually
 followed by a short prayer.
