

Consequently, it is difficult to assess the
characteristics of the disease in the
absence of a clear history of the disease.
In addition, the clinical presentation
of the disease is often non-specific and
can be confused with other diseases.
The diagnosis is usually made by a combination
of clinical presentation and laboratory tests.
Treatment is mainly supportive and includes
rest, fluids, and pain relief.
In severe cases, hospitalization may be required.
Complications can include respiratory distress,
sepsis, and septic shock.
Prognosis is generally good, especially if treated early.
However, complications can occur, particularly in the elderly and those with underlying
medical conditions.
