

Abbeary to the Pope of the Roman Church
 On the 10th day of the month of June
 the year of our Lord 1274
 the Pope received a letter from the
 Abbeary of the Holy Sepulchre
 in Jerusalem containing the
 following petition:

We request that you would be
 pleased to grant us the privilege
 of having a certain number of
 monks in our monastery who
 should be exempt from all
 secular jurisdiction.

The Pope answered that he
 would grant the petition
 provided that the monks
 should be obedient to the
 Pope and his successors
 in all things that do not
 concern their exemption.

The Abbeary then wrote
 to the Pope expressing their
 gratitude and promising
 to remain obedient to his
 authority in all things
 that do not touch their
 exemption.

The Pope then issued a
 bull confirming the
 privilege granted to the
 Abbeary of the Holy
 Sepulchre.
