handsome specimen. The shell is about
one and a half inches long, and is
nearly as wide at the base. The surface
is covered with numerous small
irregular tubercles, which are
more prominent on the upper surface
than on the lower. The shell is
brownish-yellow, with darker
brown spots and streaks.
The animal is very active,
and moves rapidly over the sand.
It has two long tentacles
extending from the head,
and a pair of short tentacles
near the mouth. The body
is elongated, and tapers
towards the tail. The fins
are well developed, and
the gills are numerous.
The shell is smooth, and
the surface is covered with
numerous small tubercles,
which are more prominent
on the upper surface than
on the lower. The shell is
brownish-yellow, with darker
brown spots and streaks.
The animal is very active,
and moves rapidly over the sand.
It has two long tentacles
extending from the head,
and a pair of short tentacles
near the mouth. The body
